FOLLOW-UP REPORT SHOWS POSITIVE RESULTS

VICTORIA – A cumulative analysis of Auditor General follow-up reports found that 99.5% of the examined recommendations are being actioned by the audited organizations, with 92% completed or substantially completed.

“I am extremely pleased with these results,” said John Doyle. “Recommendations are issued to improve the management of government resources and responsibilities and such a high implementation rate speaks to the relevancy of our work and the dedication of public servants in this province.”

The figures were published as part of the Auditor General’s most recent follow-up report, tabled today.

“With only two of the 467 recommendations outstanding, these follow-up reports clearly demonstrate the positive results that can and will continue to be achieved through the audit and review processes,” said Doyle. “As always, I invite Members of the Legislative Assembly and other readers to provide feedback on which areas or responses may warrant further work.”
